- Citizens from Canada, Japan, Australia, New Zealand can apply in Dublin but also directly with the Immigration Office in Germany
- Citizens from Israel, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Republic of Korea and Brazil must apply at the Embassy/Consulates in their country
